### Residential Parking Permits

In 2015 the City of Hudson implemented a residential parking restriction on Spruce Drive. Spruce Drive is part of Residential Parking Restriction – Zone A (Hudson High School Area). Being part of the restriction assists in alleviating traffic congestion, illegal parking and related health and safety hazards. A “Parking Permit” sign is posted at the West end of Spruce Drive, nearest to the High School.

The restriction is enforced by the Hudson Police Department during Zone A hours, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on school days. Warning tickets and citations are becoming more common when cars are parked on Spruce Drive during these hours without a Residential Parking Permit.

Residents abutting Spruce Drive are eligible for two household permits and two guest permits. Those wishing to obtain a permit, please stop at Hudson City Hall (reception desk) to complete the form and provide proof of residence (drivers license). The form is then routed to Police Chief Jensen for resident abbutal verification, approval and permit issuance.
